### CARBON MONOXIDE AND WHY?

- Who? - Anyone with a home that has fuel burning appliances (furnace, water heater, gas dryer, gas stove, and fire places).
- Where? - On each level of the home and near sleeping areas, and near garages.
- Why? - Carbon monoxide is colorless and odorless and that is very dangerous since you do not know it is present without a detector. The detector will alert you and allow us to send the fire department.
- Call our service department to add to your home system.



### SMOKE DETECTORS AND WHY?

- Smoke detectors should be in every bedroom and hall and on each floor.
- If we think back to our grandparents house when radios and televisions were housed in a wood cabinet and couches and bedding were made of cotton, rugs were made of wool, "natural products" fire was slower and less dangerous.
- Today everything is plastic and contains oil products and toxic fumes are far more dangerous and fire actually spreads faster.
- The correct answer is more detection, a planned escape route and the fire department being called earlier.
