CARBON MONOXIDE AND WHY?

- Who? Anyone with a home that has fuel burning appliances (furnace, water heater, gas dryer, gas stove, and fire places).
- Where? On each level of the home and near sleeping areas, and near garages.
- Why? Carbon monoxide is colorless and odorless and that is very dangerous since you do not know it is present without a detector. The detector will alert you and allow us to send the fire department.
- Call our service department to add to your home system.



SMOKE DETECTORS AND WHY?

 Smoke detectors should be in every bedroom and hall and on each floor.

If we think back to our grandparents house

when radios and televisions were housed in a wood cabinet and couches and bedding were made of cotton, rugs



were made of wool, "natural products" fire was slower and less dangerous.

- Today everything is plastic and contains oil products and toxic fumes are far more dangerous and fire actually spreads faster.
- The correct answer is more detection, a planned escape route and the fire department being called earlier.
